# COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

#### COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

#### **PURPOSE**

The New Hope Church College Scholarship Program exists to promote education beyond high school. Scholarships may be awarded annually to members of New Hope Church who are attending their first, second, third or fourth year of an accredited college or university on a fulltime basis. Generally, scholarships are awarded based upon academic performance, writing skills, church involvement and other extracurricular activities. Funds for scholarships are provided solely by donations from generous church members and other donors; annual scholarship amounts are based upon the amount of available funds and the number of eligible applicants.

#### MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a college scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Must be a member of New Hope Church for at least six (6) months; and
- 2. Must be enrolled, and working toward a degree, at an accredited college or university as a full-time 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th year student; and
- 3. Must have established and maintained at least a 2.0 ("C") grade point average (GPA). For 1st year college students, final overall high school GPAs will be considered.

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE AND SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a scholarship, Applicants that meet the Minimum Eligibility Requirements must submit a complete "College Scholarship Application Packet" no later than Midnight on Saturday, December 8, 2018 – No Exceptions!

A College Scholarship Application Packet includes: 1) a fully completed College Scholarship Application; 2) an Essay on one of the topics specified in the College Scholarship Application; 3) at least three Written Reference Letters; and 4) the following attachments:

#### Required Attachments for 1st Year College Students (Copies are acceptable)

- 1. College Acceptance Letter
- 2. High School Report Card which shows applicant's final GPA and last card marking GPA
- 3. Current class schedule or other documentation that shows applicant's "full-time" college status

#### Required Attachments for 2nd, 3rd & 4th Year College Students (Copies are acceptable)

- 1. College Report Card which shows applicant's GPA for the most recent card marking
- 2. Documentation of applicant's overall college GPA to date
- 3. Current class schedule or other documentation that shows applicant's "full-time" college status

The Applicant is responsible for ensuring that his/her complete application packet is timely submitted regardless of the delivery method. Failure to submit a fully completed application may result in the application not being evaluated.

#### SCHOLARSHIP AWARD DECISIONS

The New Hope Church Scholarship Committee is responsible for all decisions pertaining to college scholarship awards. College scholarship award decisions will be based upon the quality and completeness of *Scholarship Information Packets* timely submitted by applicants that meet the Minimum Eligibility Requirements. Applications submitted by applicants that do <u>not</u> meet the Minimum Eligibility Requirements may not be considered.

All scholarship award recipients will be notified of their award. Scholarship award decisions may also be announced during a Sunday worship service.

#### **MAKING DONATIONS**

No church monies are budgeted or designated for the College Scholarship Fund. Rather, funds are provided solely through the generosity of New Hope Church members and other donors.
